





Global Aluminum Use by Product Form














FRP Demand in Global and Asia

Global Aluminium FRP Demand



- Harbor predicts stagnation in Europe while Novelis expects growth in Can and Auto


Novelis View Participation in 2011 to 2015 Growth by Region Harbor View Participation in 2011 to 2015 Growth by Region


Asia Aluminum FRP Demand Growth by product




Novelis Commitment to China

- Opened a new Business Development & Sales Office in Shanghai in September 2011
- Building the Shanghai team
 - Hired a Managing Director James Liu
 - Total Resources: 8 people as of Feb. 1st, 2012, ramping-up to 12 people by April 2012
- Actively investigating Development Opportunities:
 - Greenfield Investment
 - Site selection work complete
 - Business Plan developed and well supported
 - Phase 1: ~\$100 Million US in Fixed Assets
 (Target: Construction start summer 2012 → S.O.P.: Fall 2014)
 - Phase 2: In excess of \$1.0 Billion US
 - Acquisition Targets
 - In discussion


